Consequences for Level 1, 2, 3 and 4

I. Level One

- a. Warning/Counsel Student
- b. Phone call home with alternate writing assignment
- c. Teacher directed detention
- d. Referral to office: with copy of Intervention Log including phone number to parents and comments

II. Level Two

- a. Phone call home (Mandatory)
- b. Counsel student
- c. Detention
- d. In School Suspension

III. Level Three

- a. Phone call home (Mandatory)
- b. Counsel student
- c. In School Suspension
- d. Saturday School
- e. Out of school suspension (1 to 10 days)
- f. Civil citation/Arrest (Law Enforcement)

IV. Level Four

- a. Phone call home (Mandatory)
- b. Out of school suspension
- c. Recommendation for Expulsion
 - i. Back on Track- four counseling sessions and behavior contract (Return to home school)
 - ii. Referral to Alternative School-
 1. ESE
 2. Non-ESE
- d. Civil citation/Arrest (Law Enforcement)

Note: Consequences will be assessed and assigned by the grade level Administrator. Expulsions will be recommended by the Principal. Arrest/Civil Citation will be recommended by the Principal and Law Enforcement.
