





Positive Behavior Support Targets "Following Directions"

For the month of March, the entire staff will be catching students following directions the first time they are asked. There will be video lessons on how to follow directions in the classroom and on the bus. The most important message we want students to learn is that it is respectful and safe to follow directions from the adults in charge the first time they are asked to do something. The steps used to teach this skill are;

1. Listen carefully to what is being said. 
2. Think about it. 
3. Ask for help if needed. 
4. Just do it! 

Please encourage your children to follow directions the first time they are asked to do something. Remember to praise, praise, and praise them when they follow your directions or any other adult's directions the first time they are asked.

Students will be earning a star with their name on it when they get caught following directions the first time they are asked. These stars are going to be displayed in the first part of C building (library) to recognize the efforts of these students. Students will be able to bring their stars home after they are displayed throughout March and May.
