

PAWS (Positive Actions Warrant Success) Cards –

Platinum, Gold, Silver, Bronze & Diamond Cards are positive incentive rewards given to those students who maintain high academic grades and superior behavior. The card holders have specific privileges awarded to them depending upon the level of card. Partners in Education vendors also award the card holders with prizes, gifts, food, etc. PAWS Incentive cards will be confiscated from those students who receive an all day in-school suspension (ISS), or Out of School Suspension (OSS). *A student may not receive a “D or F” or “N or U” on the report card and still receive a platinum, gold, silver or bronze card.*

Requirements for a Platinum Card

4.0 grade point average, no suspensions, no all day ISS or OSS.

Requirements for a Gold Card

3.75 – 3.99 grade point average, no “D” or “F”, no suspensions, no all day ISS or OSS.

Requirements for a Silver Card

3.50 - 3.74 grade point average, no “D” or “F”, no suspensions, no all day ISS or OSS.

Requirements for a Bronze Card

3.0 - 3.49 grade point average, no “D” or “F”, no suspensions, no all day ISS or OSS.

Requirements for a Diamond Card

For those students who could not meet the above parameters for PAWS Card but increase their overall school performance and behavior on approval by their Team, Counselors, or Administrators. These students are considered as “*Diamonds in the Rough*” and are given a positive reward for their efforts. Items to be evaluated may include but not limited to: improved GPA, decrease in discipline referrals, increase in attendance, etc. Students who receive an all day in-school suspension (ISS), or Out of School Suspension (OSS) may be eligible for a Diamond Card only with Administrative/Designee approval.
