



Positive Behavior Support At Lake Park Elementary

At Lake Park Elementary, PBS is a school wide initiative for improving student behavior by teaching the students appropriate procedures and behaviors in various locations and situations using positively stated rules and guidelines. Our school-wide behavior expectations are: to be respectful, responsible and ready to learn.

To reduce referrals school-wide classes can earn a 1, 2, or 3 by being respectful, responsible and ready to learn in their related arts classes, in the cafeteria, and on the playground. If a “1” is earned they can mark one of the boxes on their 3R’s chart (33 squares). Each time the chart is filled the class earns a reward.

Individually, children can be chosen by an adult on campus to be a “Pawsome” student. This award is given for an outstanding display of respect, responsibility or readiness to learn. Being chosen as a “Pawsome” student is an “Awesome” behavior award. The child receives the award on duplicate paper. The white copy goes home and the yellow copy is put into our “Pawsome” student box in the Media Center. Every Friday one “Pawsome” student is drawn to receive a \$10 gift certificate from several choices. Each week is a new opportunity to be a “Pawsome” student and enter their yellow slip in the drawing.

Additionally, each classroom has their own reward systems for following the rules.
