



What is PBS?

PBS is ...

Proactive: trying to prevent inappropriate behavior through clear expectations

Educative: teaching students the behaviors we expect in different settings throughout the school

Reinforcement Based: rewarding students for following the expectations and rules

Consequences: students still given consequences for inappropriate behavior

What does PBS look like at SPE?

- There are five clear expectations for success.
- Teachers, staff, and students are able to state and explain the expectations and rules.
- Students are taught behaviors they are expected to display.
- Teachers continuously teach the expectations and rules.
- Teachers know what behaviors to manage and what behaviors to refer to administration.
- Students are rewarded for meeting expectations, following rules, and showing good character.

The PBS Goal

To consistently and continually teach behaviors and expectations to students to decrease student referrals and improve behavior school wide.
