Expectations	Rules
1. Be Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Listen and respect others ideas• Work with team members/classmates• Be an active listener• Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself• Raise hand to speak
2. Be Responsible	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Come to class on time• Be prepared to learn with all supplies and materials ready• Complete all tasks
3. Be a Role Model	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Share ideas with others• Accept help from others• Keep trying (persevere)

Expectations	Rules
1. Be Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Use quiet inside voices▪ Use polite manners “Please” and “Thank you”▪ Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself
2. Be Responsible	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Walk quietly to designated line▪ Raise your hand for permission to leave your seat▪ Hold tray with 2 hands▪ Walk to trash and door quietly
3. Be a Role Model	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Help keep your area clean▪ Have your choice ready when you come to line▪ Have condiments/ utensils before you sit▪ Use your time wisely “Eat instead of talk”



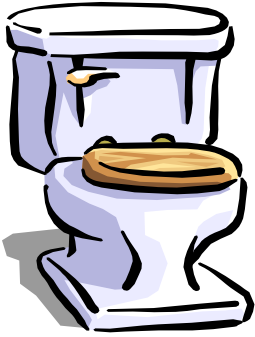
Hallway

Expectations	Rules
1. Be Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Walk silently• Walk single file and stay to the right• Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself
2. Be Responsible	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Stop at intersections• Walk to designated area• Walk facing forward
3. Be a Role Model	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Leave space between you and the person in front of you• Be courteous to classrooms that you are passing



Playground

Expectations	Rules
1. Be Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use polite language• Use kind hands• Use equipment appropriately
2. Be Responsible	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Walk quietly to line the <u>first</u> time your teacher's name is called• Walk quietly to designated area• Think safety first
3. Be a Role Model	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use cooperation and friendship• Use patience and care when waiting your turn• Act with kindness



Restroom

Expectations	Rules
1. Be Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Throw trash in trash bins• Keep water in sink• Use faucet/toilet appropriately
2. Be Responsible	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Conserve materials (2 paper towels and 2 squirts of soap)• Clean up after yourself
3. Be a Role Model	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use patience when waiting your turn• Notify your teacher of any wrong doing



Bus

Expectations	Rules
1. Be Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use a quiet voice on the bus• Use kind manners• Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself
2. Be Responsible	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Go directly to your seat• Sit with your back against the seat and your feet on the floor in front of you• Keep your backpack by your feet or on your lap• Stay seated until bus comes to a complete stop
3. Be a Role Model	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Help keep bus clean• Safety first – keep all materials in your backpack



Morning and Afternoon

Arrival and Dismissal

Expectations	Rules
1. Be Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use quiet voices• Listen to and follow directions given by safety patrols/adults• Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself
2. Be Responsible	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Walk to designated area and remain seated• Sit “criss-cross” with backpack on your back• Arrive in the morning no earlier than 7:45 a.m. and no later than 8:15 a.m.
3. Be a Role Model	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sit in an orderly line• Allow enough space between you and your neighbor
