Information System (SWIS) is a web-based information system designed to help school personnel to use office referral data to design school-wide and individual student interventions.

SWIS

By using an efficient, computer system for gathering information, SWIS will generate practical reports to help in decision making.

Evaluation:

Individual student behavior

Behavior of **groups** of students

Behavior in **specific settings**

Behavior during **specific times** of the school day

The SWIS™ reports give data that will allow teachers and administrators to shape school-wide environments to maximize students' academic and social achievements.

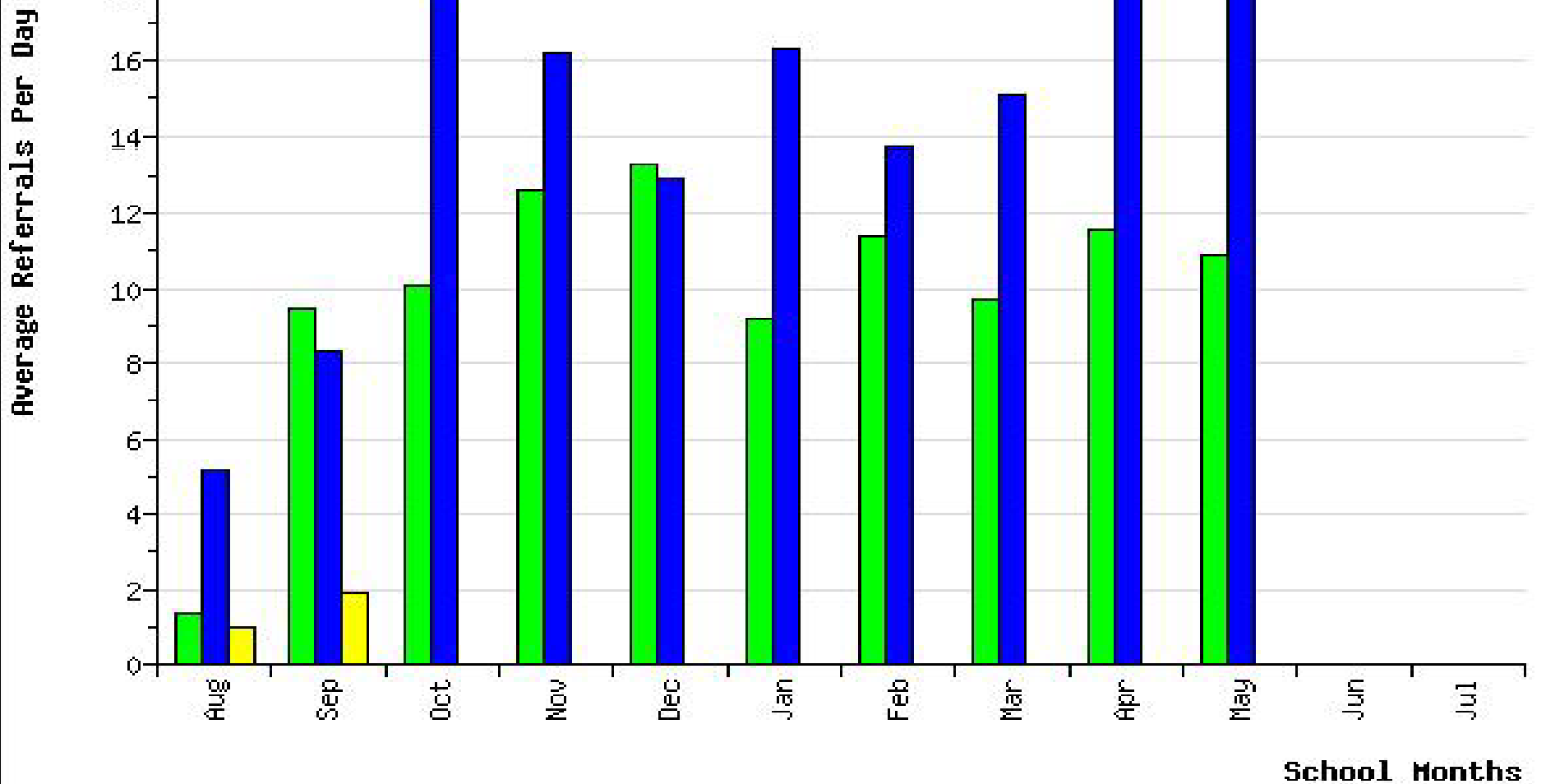
Samples of **SWIS** Reports

- 1) office referrals per day per month
- 2) the location of the problem behaviors
- 3) the type of problem behaviors
- 4) the time the problem behaviors occur
- 5) how many children were referred for problem behaviors.

Average Referrals Per Day Per Month

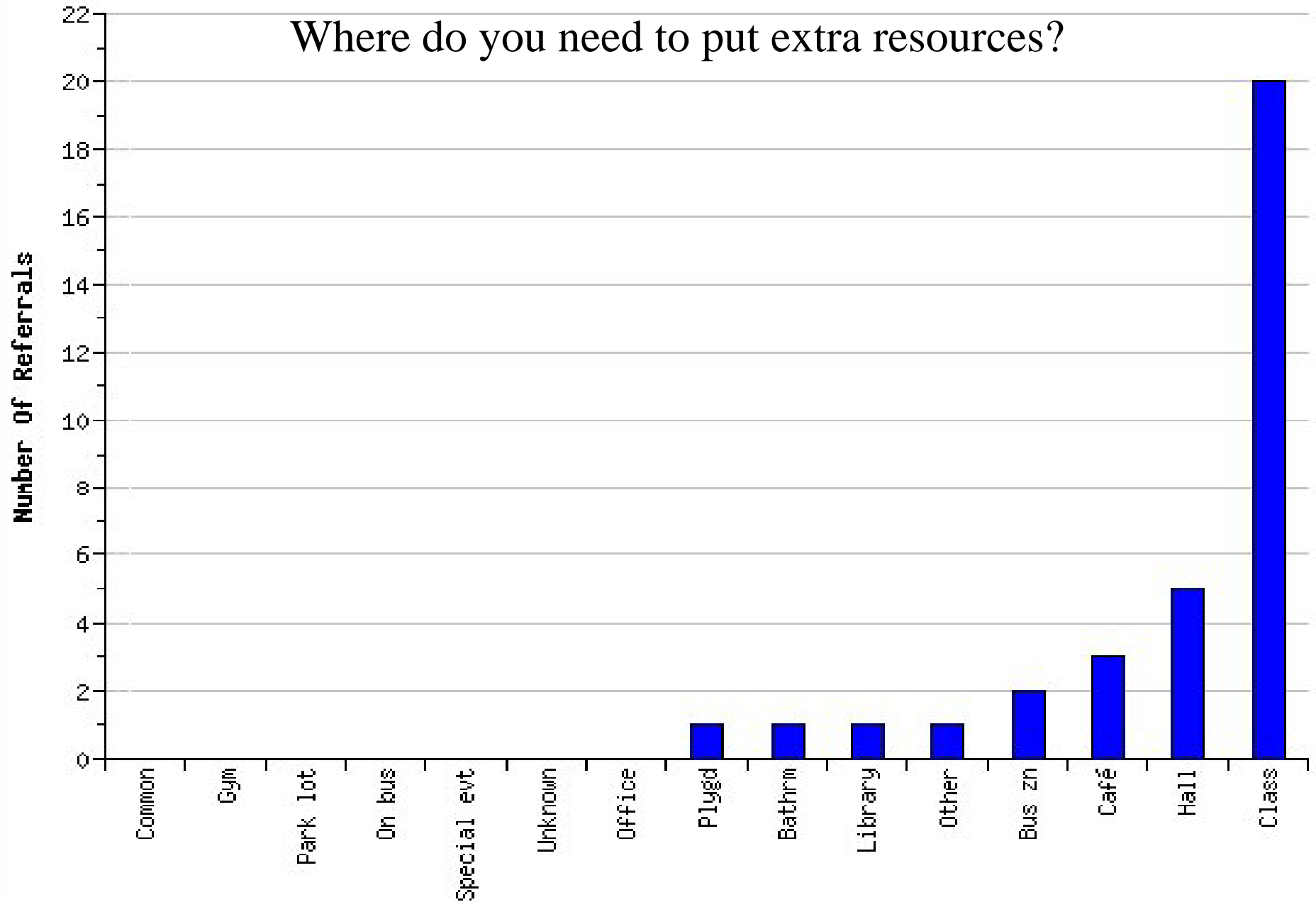

Implement strategies.



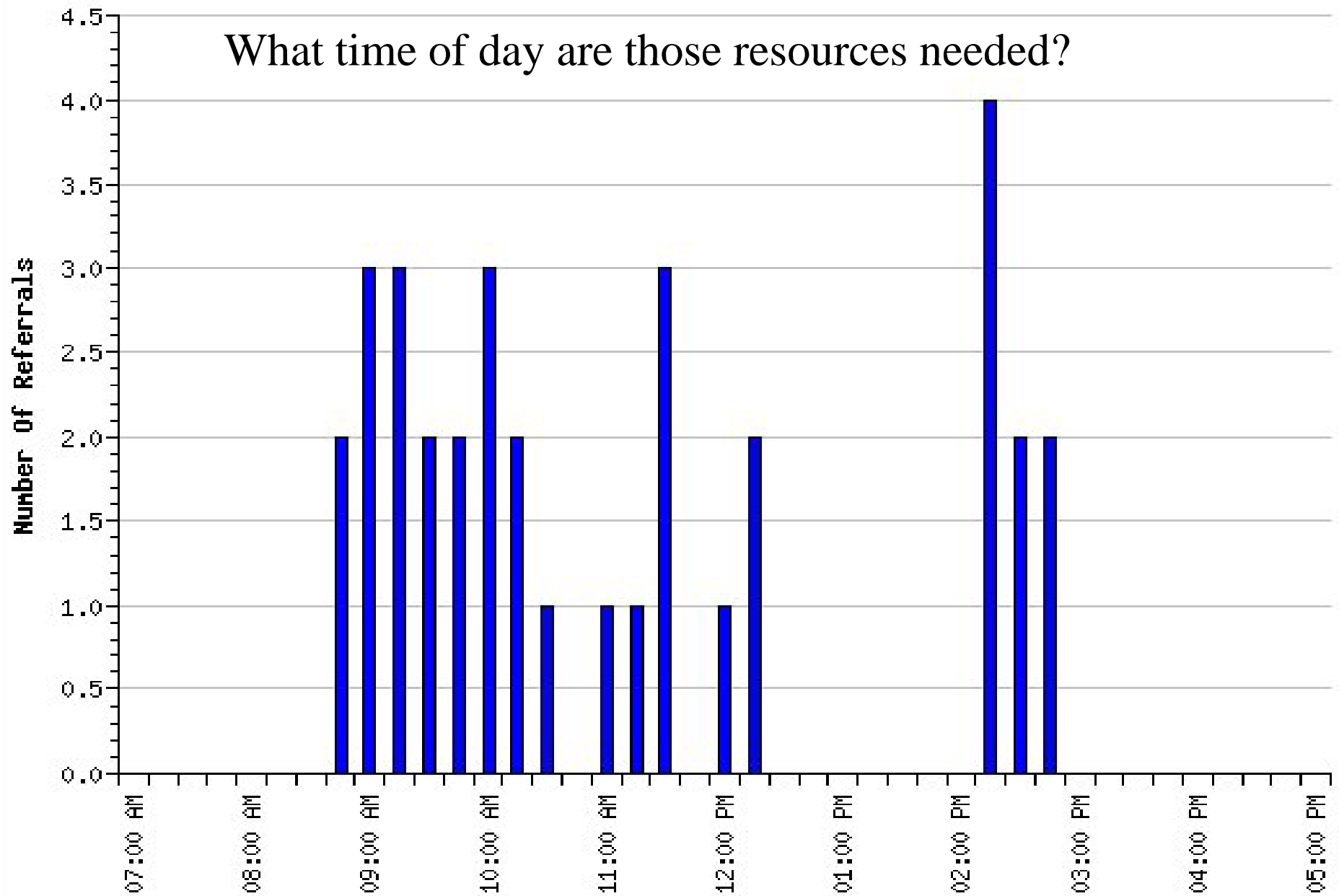
Referrals by Location

Where do you need to put extra resources?



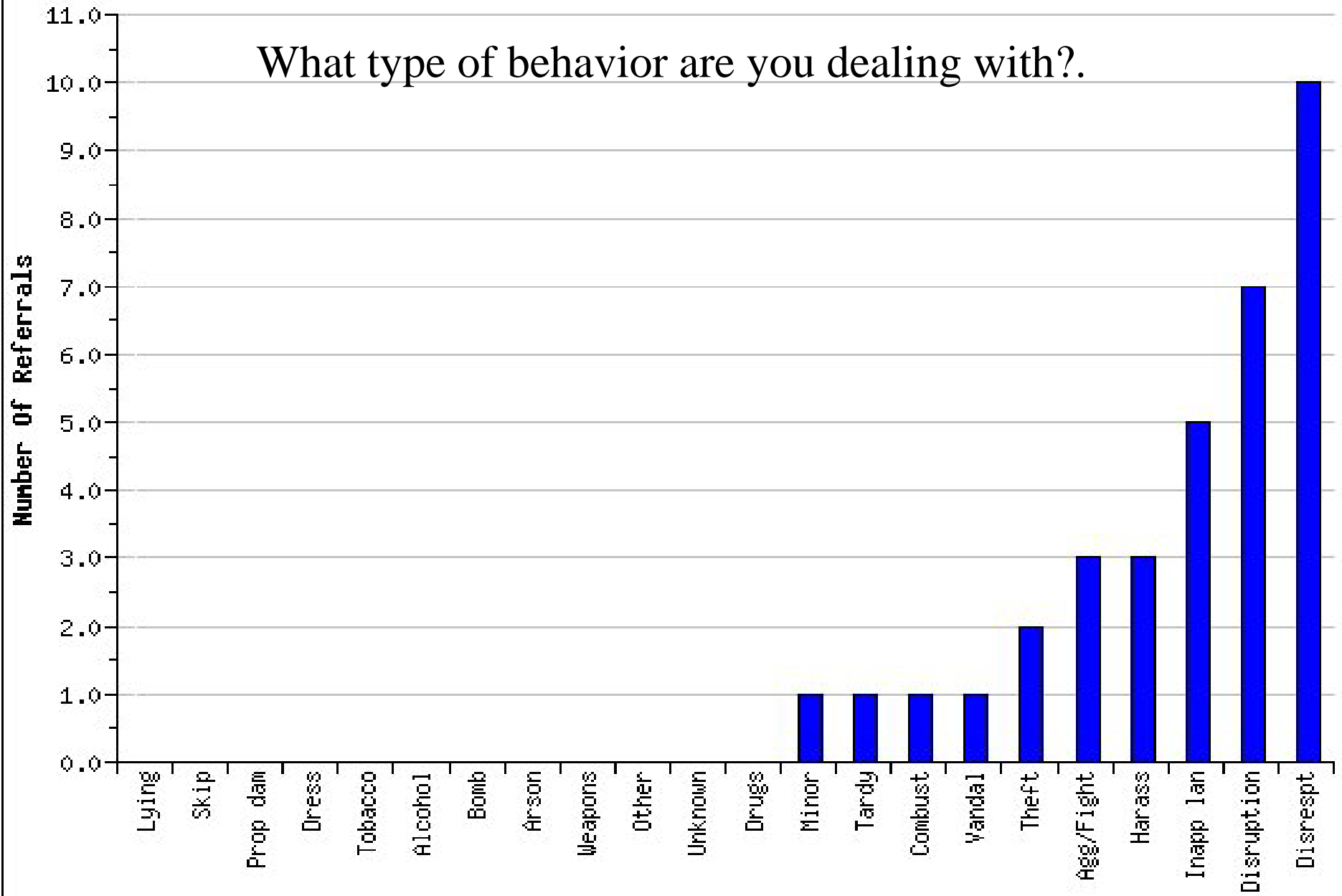
Referrals by Time
