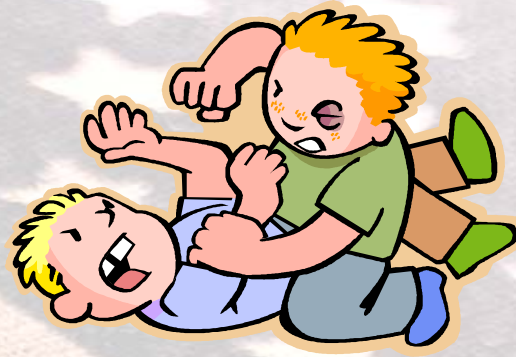

Behavioral Principles:

Referral Process:

- Minor referrals written at teacher discretion
- Must be sent home and signed by parent
- Copy kept in personal file and copy turned into Danielle Gilman....school safety for data purposes!
- Major referrals sent to administration where consequence will be determined!

Specific Infractions:

- **Minor Referrals:**

- Inappropriate Verbal Language
- Aggression
- Defiance/Disrespect/Non-Compliance
- Disruption
- Dress Code
- Electronic Technology Violation
- Property Misuse
- Other

- **Major Referrals:**

- Abusive Behavior/Language
- Defiance/Disrespect/Disruption
- Fighting/Physical Aggression
- Insubordination
- Harassment/Tease
- Lying/Cheating
- Physical Contact
- Theft/Forgery
- Vandalism/Property Damage
- Other

Crisis Plan:

- ASAP = Walk



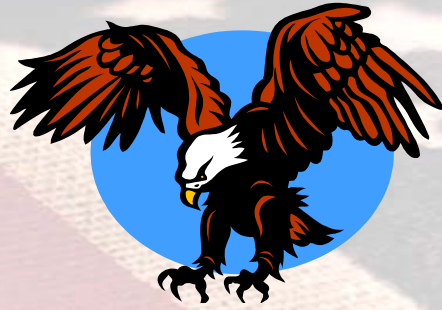
- Immediately = RUN

Be a STAR PATRIOT Pledge:



Today I will do my best to be a STAR Patriot!

I will be Kind.

I will be Respectful.

I will be Responsible.

I will be Safe.

I will be the Best I can be.

I know it is up to me.


Pledge will be done every morning on the morning show.

Every classroom as well as specified areas, ex.....cafeteria, will receive a poster that states the Expectations and the Star pledge.

Eagles: Individual Incentive




🦅 Students are able to earn eagles for demonstrating Star Expectations as well as Character Traits.

🦅 Eagles will be provided to start the school-year.

🦅 Teachers will have the flexibility to have an incentive program in their classroom to reward the students for eagles earned.

🦅 Co-teaching teams need to be taken into consideration for incentives.

💡 Protocol 2.....Team Unity!



Flag/Stars: Class Incentive



- ★ Classes will be given a flag to design at the beginning of the school-year. Designing of flag will be done by homeroom classes.
- ★ Classes are able to earn small (red, white, and blue) stars to collect in their classroom for demonstrating Star Patriot Expectations and Character Traits.
- ★ Each class will have to come up with a container to collect stars.
- ★ 10 stars will exchange for a big star to add to classroom flag.
- ★ On average a class can earn 3 stars per day to be able to reach the 50 star goal for the classroom flag.

Classroom Flag







The Big stars will represent the US States and will be put in order of statehood. All stars will be provided to staff along with the order they will be given.

- Staff will receive an [incentive chart](#) to display in their classrooms for reaching specific goals...

10 – End of day Board Games
20 – Free Recess
30 – Lunch with Teacher
40 - End of day Activity/Popcorn
50 - Pizza Party

The goal is to collect all 50 stars by the end of the school-year. There will be a whole school celebration for reaching the 50 star goal.

Patriot of the Week

-  Choose a Positive Patriot of the week who exhibits the Star Patriot Expectations!
-  Announce the Patriot of the Week on Friday within class!
-  Student will receive a certificate (found on the shared drive), a pencil, and a pin!
-  Send name of student to Andy Reuben who will announce the students names on the announcements the following week.
-  K/1 will be announced on Monday, 2/3 on Tuesday, and 4/5 on Wednesday!
-  Students will wear their pins the entire week so everyone knows they earned the Patriot of the Week!

Procedures for Specific Settings

• Cafeteria:

- Sit and Stick
- Raise Hand
- Quiet Voice
- Hands and Feet to Self
- Clean up

• Hallway:

- Stay to the Right
- Quiet Voice
- Always Walk
- Hands and Feet to Self

• Playground:

- Use Equipment Properly
- Stay in Designated Area
- Have Fun

• Restroom:

- Flush
- Clean Area
- Wash Hands
