We are concerned about problematic behavior on your child's bus. As you know, we are a model Positive Behavior Support (PBS) school and have created a plan based on this model to address the problems on the bus. Beginning on _____, the bus driver will evaluate student behavior on every ride. Each student will receive a card that they must have with them when they ride the bus. If they follow directions on the bus, the driver will punch their card to recognize their good behavior. When they have received 9 punches on their card, they will bring it to the principal who will congratulate them and award them with a coupon for a free treat at Burger King. They will also receive a new card at that time.

Please help us make this successful by talking to your child about the importance of safety and good behavior on the bus. The Beachland bus rules are:

- 1. Follow your Driver's directions.**
- 2. Stay in your seat, facing forward.**
- 3. Keep the aisles clear.**
- 4. Keep your hands and feet to yourself.**
- 5. Use your inside voice.**
- 6. Treat others the way you want to be treated.**
