*Positive Behavior Support (PBS)* seeks to teach and reward desired behaviors. At Beachland, we encourage children to: Be respectful, Be responsible, Be safe and ready to learn (the 3 Bs). When students are observed displaying these behaviors, they are rewarded with a ticket.

As most of you know, these tickets are collected and on the last Wednesday of each month, students who have earned the desired number of tickets participate in **Wonderful Wednesday** Recess where they receive treats and have a chance to win fun prizes in grade-level drawings.

While much of the funds for the program are raised through the School Store (available on Fridays), we are seeking donations to help purchase more prizes for the students—as well as to support efforts for next year.
