## Connecting Positive Behavior Support Between Home and School



ORB is continuing its implementation of school wide positive behavior support which involves teaching positive social skills and recognizing students who are engaging in appropriate behaviors. Children receive "Paw Bucks" which may be exchanged for rewards or participation in special activities.

We encourage parents to extend the school expectations into the home in order to make more permanent behaviors changes. The expectations and suggestions on how to relate these behaviors to your rules at home are as follows:

**Be Respectful** Say thanks and please, ask for help in a calm voice, allow time for others in the bathroom, wait to take a second serving of food until everyone has had a first serving.

**Be a Learner** Read for fun and information, try new things, ask questions, and explore your environment.

**Be Safe** Walk with a buddy, Wear a bike helmet when biking, know how to call 911 in an emergency, keep doors locked if home alone.

**Be Responsible** Get up on time and make your bed, do your homework and remember to bring it to school, admit your mistakes and apologize if you need to, go to bed on time.

### A Reminder from the Clinic.....

A couple of reminders for the parents of children receiving prescription medications at school:



- All medications must be picked-up from the Clinic by an adult by the last day of school. Any medications left will be disposed of per School Board policy.
- Medication orders from the Doctor do not carry over from year to year. At the beginning of next school year if you child is still on medication, you will need to supply the Clinic with new Doctor orders, and a new supply of medication.
- The Clinic will have forms for the new Doctor orders with instructions available when you pick up any left over medications.
