JD Parker Elementary has accomplished many things over the past 4 years of implementation of the PBS process. The PBS team as well as the entire school staff has worked extremely hard this 2007-2008 school year to attain model school status.

Below you will find a list of items that show all the hard work, dedication and commitment to the PBS process JD Parker Elementary has.

1. The PBS team, along with students created 3 videos on the PBS expectations. Videos are on 8 mm tape and can be copied and mailed at a later date.
2. Parker received 4 grants this year through Character Counts. Two of them were directly related and tied to PBS. 1. Peacemaking 2. Bibliotherapy
3. The May PTO was dedicated to PBS. This is a great avenue to bring PBS into the community.
4. JD Parker has aligned PBS into the RTI process. They have created a Tier III intervention to help their “frequent flyers”. (An adopted version of the check in/check out system) The parent liaison at the school was united with 2 individuals who are skilled in the area of behavior. They were given the title Academic Interventionist. Together the three staff members worked on plans for individual students who had received 5 or more major referrals. The parent liaison worked along side the Interventionist and included the parents of those children into the intervention as well.
5. Parker has 2 School Improvement Plans. One for District and one for being a Title 1 school.
6. PBS information is disseminated via morning announcements, Rocket News, and email.
7. This year JD Parker opened a school store. It is open every Thursday during lunch hours and the students buy items and activities using their

“Awesome A’s”. Next school years goal is to find a community sponsor to assist in supporting the store. The PBS team is looking to add the PBS store onto its “Adopt a Class” program.

8. PBS data is posted at all times in the front office hallway.

9. Every morning in addition to PBS information, Parker has adopted a research based program named, “Project Wisdom”, which is a daily behavioral/character announcement given to the students and staff on the Rocket News.

10. Parker has also created the MOVE room at their school. MOVE stands for Multiple Opportunities for Varying Exercise. This was added as a proactive intervention to assist those students that need sensory/physical input more often.

11. The PBS team has added more exciting incentives for their reward events. This school year they had a local dance troop, a magician and a bike give away.

12. Lunch with the Principal is a common occurrence at JD Parker. Students cash in their “Awesome A’s” to have Lunch with MRS. White.

13. Our PBS Secretary keep a loge of all the PBS minutes from the monthly meetings. (Note furnished upon request)

14. At the beginning of the school year, Mary White the Principal created a power point presentation for the entire staff. It was a “kick-off” to celebrate all of the schools accomplishments from the past year and to review the SWIS data. (Please let me know if you would like me to ask he for it) The staff was given tickets and prizes and the PBS team donated breakfast to the staff.
