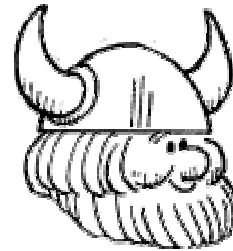

What is PBS?

WHAT IS PBS?

PBS is a Behavior system that uses effective instructional strategies, consistent correction procedures, logical consequences and positive reinforcement to teach students the skills and behaviors necessary for their current and future success.

This approach to behavior can occur on a school-wide level, in a specific setting, classroom, or with an individual student.

JBE EXPECTATIONS

Be Respectful: To treat a person, place or thing politely and kindly

Be Responsible: Keeping your word/doing your share of the work/owning your words and actions

Be Safe: Acting in ways that keep you and others from harm or the possibility of harm.



TEACHING THE EXPECTATIONS

Every month the PBS team will meet to look at the data gathered on student behavior and target an expectation, location, grade level, etc... that demonstrated a need for further education in school expectations. Students will be directly taught examples and non-example of the targeted expectations and will then receive 'bees' for demonstrating that behavior which can later be turned in for prizes.



REWARDS

Students are rewarded with bees for demonstrating one of the expectations. When a student has collected 5 bees he/she may trade them in for a prize, a chance to win a raffle or entry to an event. Prizes range from pencil erasers to game boys or bikes.

CONSEQUENCES

Administration has a list of consequences developed through the collaboration of faculty, staff and administration on the Positive Behavior Support team. When a student demonstrates a negative behavior the teacher will write the activities that occurred prior to, during and following the behavior. This information will be put into a secure data base to help determine the function or reason for the behavior. This will allow faculty and staff to educate students in how to demonstrate school expectation
