

E.A.T. score keeping procedures for the Sadler Lunchroom:

- Each class may earn up to any thing from 0 - 5 points each day. Points are not taken away once they are earned.
- The goal for PrK-2 = 50 points. The goal for 3-5 = 100 points
- Duty Station at lunch line starts the E.A.T. score card and gives the first point, if earned by the class. Score card is given to a student who takes it to class seating.
- Lunchroom workers make notes & write points on the card throughout the lunch period.
- As the teacher arrives to pick up the class, the lunch room worker will give the E.A.T.

score card to the teacher. The class keeps a tally of points in the classroom.

- When the goal for the class has been reached, email Nancy and the certificate will be delivered very soon.
- Each class is eligible to win. If a class does not earn enough points in a month, the points will roll over to the next.

E.A.T. Score Card Sample:

E	Enter & Exit Safely	A	Always Use Good Manners	T	Take Time to Clean Up
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- Enter safely
(walking in line, hands to self, quiet voices)
- Use good manners
(eating food, sitting at table)
- Use good tone of voice
(quiet conversation, polite words)
- Stand and clean up
(clean table & floor, line up at the scullery)
- Exit safely
(walking in line, waiting politely for teacher, quiet voices)
