



**WOLF EYES**  
**POSITIVE BEHAVIOR REFERRAL**

A Wolf Eyes Referral has been developed to reward students for demonstrating appropriate behaviors consistent with Timber Creek's Wolf Etiquette Expectations. The Wolf Eyes Referral is used to recognize students who have demonstrated improvements in their positive behavior. Students who are given a Wolf Eyes Referral (Positive Behavior Referral) demonstrate Wolf Etiquette behavior in a one-time situation and/or on a daily basis throughout the school year.

We highly encourage all of Timber Creek's teachers and staff to refer students as often as possible in order for us to be able to positively recognize students. Each teacher will be given a folder with referrals and examples of behaviors at the beginning of the year and additional referrals will be provided as needed.

Wolf Etiquette Behavior falls into at least one of the four categories. Below are examples of behaviors that can be improved and rewarded.
