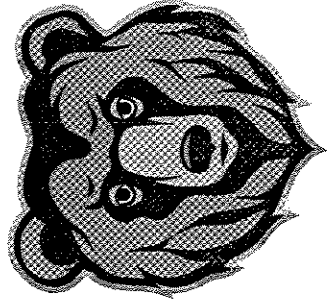
Narcoossee Pride Club
