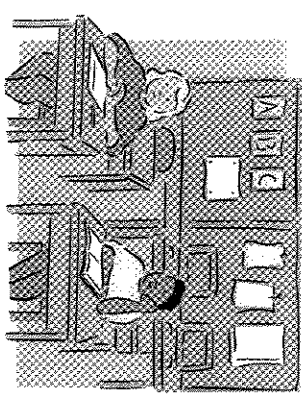

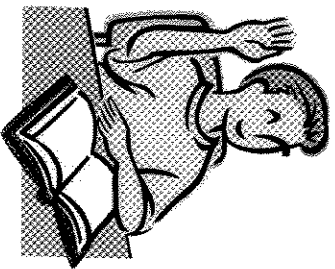

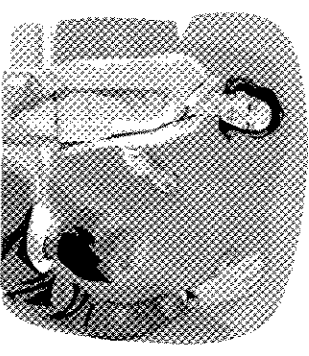

Guidelines for Class Rules

Pioneers are Respectful, Responsible and Problem Solvers.

- All teachers should have class rules. Teachers in Child Clusters should have the same rules.
- Everyone must be consistent when enforcing class/cluster rules.
- Post rules in your classroom in an area that is visible to all students.
- State rules positively (e.g. “Keep your hands and feet to yourself.” instead of “Do not touch others.”).
- Keep class rules tied to the school wide expectations (the Pioneer Three – Respectful, Responsible and Problem Solvers). Try to use the same format as used with the school wide signs that are seen in the halls, cafeteria and playground.

Assembly Expectations

Pioneers are:

Respectful

- Keep your hands and feet to yourself.
 - Be a good listener.

Responsible

- Sit quietly and face forward
 - Use indoor voices

Problem Solvers

- Think about the appropriate way to clap and praise each other.
