

Expectation: Be Prepared

Definition and Critical Attributes

To be ready for all classroom activities by having the proper tools to be successful when class begins.

Examples

- 1. Have pencils, paper and books ready for each class**
- 2. Turn in permission on time**
- 3. Have homework ready every day for every class.**
- 4. Dress for Success**

Non-Examples

- 1. No pencil**
- 2. No paper**
- 3. No PE unifom**
- 4. no instrument for band or orchestra**

Activities to Enhance Concept Development

- 1. Make a list of necessary items for each class.**
- 2. Role play proper preparations for each class.**

Activities to Check for Understanding

- 1. Do spot checks, once or twice a week and reward students who are prepared for class.**
- 2. Have a class discussion on the advantages of being prepared.**

Activities to Extend Concept Development

Have students interview parents and teachers about the advantages of being prepared.
