

Expectation: Be Respectful

Definition and Critical Attributes:

Definition – Acknowledging the feelings and interests of others and not interfering with them; being attentive; showing courtesy; being empathetic.

Examples:

1. Listening to others
2. Offering help when needed
3. Speaking kindly

Non-Examples:

1. Interrupting others
2. Being in a person's personal space
3. Gossip

Activities to Enhance Concept Development:

1. Show a teacher/student made video that depicts respectful actions.
2. Create a table with 2 columns and have students add what they think is being respectful/non-respectful
3. Write about a personal experience when students felt that they were respected.

Activities to Check for Understanding:

1. Create a group of 10 scenarios where students must determine if the situations are respectful or not.
2. Have students come up with their own scenarios that show respectful attitudes and then act them out in front of the class.
