

Office Managed Behaviors

Defiance/Disrespect/Non-Compliant

Abusive or inappropriate Language

Fighting or Physical Aggression

Disruption

Theft/Forgery

Property Damage/Vandalism

Use or Possession of Drugs/Alcohol

Tobacco

Definition

Refusal to follow directions, talking back, and/or socially rude directed toward authority

Directed threatening verbal messages that include swearing, name calling or use of inappropriate words

Two or more persons participate in physical force or violence

Any behavior that causes a major interruption of the educational process

Student is in possession of, having passed on, or being responsible for removing someone else's property or has signed a person's name without that person's permission

Intentional destruction, damage or defacement of public or private property without consent of the owner or person having custody or control of it

Use, cultivation, manufacture, distribution, sale, purchase or possession of any drug, narcotic, controlled substance or represented to be a controlled substance

Possession, use, distribution or sale of tobacco products on school grounds, at school sponsored events or on school transportation by any person under 18 years of age

Examples

Hitting, punching, hitting with an object, kicking, scratching, pulling hair, biting

Yearbook defacing, damaging textbook, carving into desk, graffiti

Tardy	Tardies that have exhausted the behavior tracking form.	
Skip Class/Truancy	Student stays out of class 5 or more minutes or is out of class without permission, student leaves class or school without permission	
Harassment/Tease/Taunt	Sustained or intense disrespectful messages (verbal or gestural) to another person that includes threats and intimidation	Obscene gestures, pictures, written notes or negative comments based upon race, religion, gender, disabilities or bullying
Sexual Harassment	Unwanted and repeated verbal or physical behavior with sexual connotations, that is severe or pervasive enough to create an intimidating, hostile or offensive educational environment, cause discomfort or humiliation or unreasonably interfere with the individual's school performance or participation	Inappropriate touching, pinching, patting rubbing, demanding sexual favors
Lying/Cheating	Student delivers a message which is untrue with intent to cause harm, embarrassment or to intimidate	Cheating on a test, cheating that goes beyond the behavior tracking form
Dress Code Violation	Students who have exhausted the steps in dress code plan (Used by SIC teacher only)	
Use or possession of weapons	Possession of any instrument or object that can inflict serious harm on another person or that can place a person in reasonable fear or apprehension of serious harm	
Out of area	Any place a student does not have permission to be
