

Teacher Managed Behaviors

Eating, drinking, chewing gum

Disruption

Horseplay

Disrespect, minor to another student or another student's belongings

Defiance to another student

Pushing or shoving

Lying/cheating

Public Display of Affection

Writing on School Property

Other Minor Violations

Throwing Objects

Tardy

Definition

Food, drinks, candy (only in the cafeteria), gum not allowed anywhere on campus

Low-intensity, but inappropriate disruption

Rough rowdy play that stops with verbal intervention with no physical harm

Making an improper gesture or comment about another person or their belongings

Refusal to work with or respond to another student's reasonable request

To willfully cause another person to move by exerting force

Student delivers a message that is untrue, and deliberately violates rules

Improper physical display of affection

Writing on school property that cannot easily be removed

Non-listed items that are disruptive

Inappropriate throwing of objects through the air

Student is one to four minutes late to class or the startup of the day (after 9:05)

Examples

Soda, chips, gum, candy, sunflower seeds, etc.

Talking, whispering, singing, humming, calling out, making disruptive noises with pencils, mouth or fingers, spitball, paper ball flatulence, note passing

Chasing, wrestling, tripping, kicking

Name calling, racial epithets, improper gestures; put downs, knocking another student's books or belongings

Refusal to share materials, pass papers, etc.

Using a part of their body to move another student

Handholding, hugging, kissing

Pencil marks in desks, texts and on walls

Writing on self or others

Pencils, paper, rocks, beads, rubber bands, oranges, etc.
