| Responsible 1. Take care of business | Promptly use the restroom | Playing around or talking with friends |
| Tolerant and Respectful 2. Flush | Flush the toilet when finished | Leave the toilet dirty. |
| Safe 3. Wash Hands | Use soap and water to clean hands. Use one towel to dry hands. | Leave the restroom without cleaning hands; not throwing towel away |
| Responsible 4. Leave | Leave the restroom promptly when finished. | Loitering in restroom; playing and/or talking with friends. |

Activities to Allow Students to Practice Desired Behaviors: Present a video role playing appropriate use of restroom; teacher will stop the video to allow for brainstorming examples and non-examples.

Plan for Rewarding Appropriate Behavior: StarBucks and verbal reinforcement specifying exactly which rule/expectation the student demonstrated correctly.
