Specific Rules for Setting		
	Examples	Non-examples
Active Learner 1. Stay focused on tasks.	Completing your work; continue working until done.	Talking or playing around while working; not completing a task
Tolerant and Respectful 2. Treat others with kindness.	Say please and thank you. Help others when needed. Use kind words and tones with others.	Teasing others. Calling names or saying unkind words to others.
Responsible 3. Always listen and follow directions.	Look at and listen to teacher during instruction; follow the directions given.	Doing assignments incorrectly; Not paying attention to teacher.
4. Responsible for yourself and materials.	Keep hands, feet and objects to yourself; use materials safely; return assignments on time.	Misplace homework or agenda; using materials unsafely;
Safe 5. Share and take turns.	Sharing materials with table mates; waiting patiently for your turn	Not allowing others to use materials;

Activities to Allow Students to Practice Desired Behaviors: Teacher presents scenarios, which groups of children can role play (only role play good choices.)

Plan for Rewarding Appropriate Behavior: StarBucks and verbal reinforcement specifying exactly which rule/expectation the student demonstrated correctly.
