<b>Minor Behavior Problem</b>	<b>Definition</b>
Abusive Language/Inappropriate Language/Conduct (toward student)	Low intensity instance of inappropriate language/conduct
Defiance/Disrespect/Insubordination/Non-Compliance	Brief or low intensity failure to respond to adult requests
Lying/Cheating	Student delivers a message that is untrue and/or deliberately violates rules for gain
Harassment/Teasing/Taunting	Student delivers a disrespectful message (verbal or physical) to another person that includes threats, intimidation, obscene gestures, pictures or written notes
Disruption	Low intensity but inappropriate interruption of the educational process
Forgery/Theft (under \$50)	Student is in possession of, having passed on, or being responsible for removing someone else's property (under \$50) or has signed a person's name without that person's permission
Property Damage	Student deliberately impairs the usefulness of property
Physical Aggression (minor)	Non-serious but inappropriate physical contact or aggression towards another student or teacher

<b>Major Problem Behavior</b>	<b>Definition</b>
Abusive Language/Inappropriate Language/Conduct (toward staff)	Inappropriate language or conduct toward a staff member
Fighting w/out restraint	Action involving serious physical contact where injury may occur but does not require physical restraint between the parties involved
Fighting w/ restraint	When two or more persons mutually participate in use of force or physical violence that requires physical restraint
Bomb Threat/False Alarm	Student delivers a message of possible explosive materials being on or near campus or a pending explosion
Tobacco	Student is in possession of or using tobacco
Alcohol	Student is in possession of or using alcohol
Drugs	Student is in possession of or using illegal substances or imitations
Weapons	Student is in possession of or using knives or guns (real or look-alike) or other objects readily capable of causing bodily harm
Vandalism/Property Damage	Student participates in an activity that results in substantial destruction or disfigurement of property
Theft (over \$10)	Student is in possession of, having passed on, or being responsible for removing someone else's property (over \$10)
Threat/Intimidation	A threat to cause physical harm to another person with or without the use of a weapon and includes the following: 1) intent, 2) fear and 3) capability
Sexual Harassment	Unwanted and repeated verbal or physical behavior with sexual connotations by a student that is severe enough to create a hostile, educational environment

Sexual Offense/Misconduct	Other sexual contact, including intercourse, without force and where victim gives consent, or subjecting another individual to lewd, sexual gestures or exposing private body parts
Sexual Battery	Forced or attempted oral, anal, or vaginal penetration by using a sexual organ or other object
Breaking/Entering	The unlawful entry with force, or unauthorized presence in a building or structure, with the intent to damage or remove property or harm a person(s)
Trespassing	To enter or remain on school grounds/campus, school transportation, or at a school-sponsored event/off campus without authorization
Robbery	The taking or attempted taking of anything of value that is owned by another person or organization, by the use of force, violence or fear
Kidnapping	Forcibly, or by threat, confining, abducting or imprisoning another person against his/her will and without lawful authority
Use/Possession of Combustibles	Student is in possession of substances/objects readily capable or causing bodily harm (firecrackers, matches, lighters, gasoline)
Arson	Student plans and/or participates in malicious burning of property
