### What Does **PBS** Look Like?

1. *Expectations are taught and followed throughout the school.*
2. *Students, staff and parents are taught the expectations throughout the year.*
3. *Students and staff are able to state the expectations.*
4. *All faculty model the PBS expectations.*
5. *Students and teachers are rewarded for using the appropriate behavior expectations.*

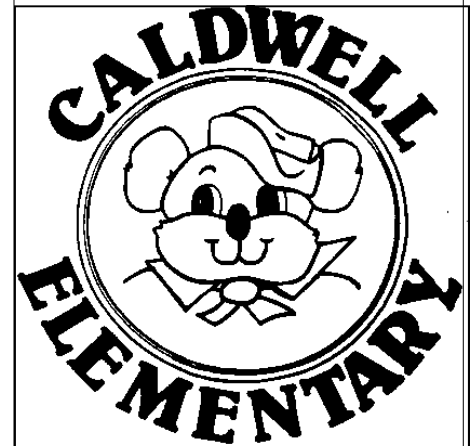
### Can Parents Help with Positive Behavior Support?

## PE Rules

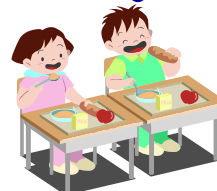
- P**— Proper and Polite Play
