

Expectation: Respect

1. Definition and Critical Attributes

To show concern and consideration: Behaviors that help people feel calmer, safer, friendlier, and more cooperative

2. Examples

- * Waiting your turn
- * Listen during lessons & when others are speaking
- * Hold the door open for others
- * Ask before touching things that belong to others
- * Use positive voice & language
- * Following directions

3. Non-Examples

- * Grab materials
- * Use inappropriate voice with others
- * Call people names
- * Make noises during lessons

4. Activities to Enhance Concept Development

Role Playing and practice
Write and/or illustrate examples
Making posters listing students definitions

5. Activities to Check for Understanding

Students write and/or illustrate examples and non-examples then categorize them.

6. Activities to Extend Concept Development

Show examples and non-examples in written and/or picture form
Assign topics for journal entry or writing assignment
Tracking examples and non-examples in video or book
Graph tracking results
