

Lesson Plans for Rules in the Restrooms

Expectations: Respectful Cooperative Responsible Cleanliness	Activity for Reviewing Expectations: Discuss school-wide expectations.	
Specific Rules for Setting		
Allow for privacy. Wait your turn. Report problems to your teacher. Flush toilet and wash hands with soap. Throw paper towels in trash can.	Examples Stand behind person while waiting or knock on stall door. Tell your teacher if a toilet or sink is stopped up or overflowing. Flush toilet when done then wash your hands with soap and water. Throw paper towels in trash can when finished.	Non-examples Crowding around the toilet or opening stall door without knocking. Allow toilets and sinks to overflow without telling the teacher. Leave the bathroom without flushing the toilet or washing your hands. Throw paper towels on floor.

Activities to Allow Students to Practice Desired Behaviors: Model correct procedure for flushing, hand washing and disposing of used paper towels.
Plan for Rewarding Appropriate Behavior: Earn tokens redeemable for prizes and special privileges.
