

**PBS CONTRACT FOR THE PRIVILEGE OF LISTENING
TO MUSIC IN THE CLASSROOM**

Agreement dated as of _____ between _____, student at Delaware Avenue School (hereinafter referred to as "STUDENT"), and _____ (hereinafter referred to as ("The TEACHER")) – agree as follows:

I. The Student agrees to abide by and obey all the Teacher rules and expectations while at Delaware Avenue School.

II. Prior to The Student using the Internet, the Student and Parent must sign the Acceptable Use Agreement with St. Lucie County Schools.

III. The Student agrees to the following guidelines concerning the music:

- Music must be kept low in volume (heard through headsets only).
- Music must not interfere with active learning of student or classroom.
- Music must not contain profane language.
- Music must not contain content of a sexual nature.
- Music must not promote drugs, alcohol, or violence.

IV. **USE OF MUSIC:** The Teacher agrees to allow the Student to use music during the following periods(s): _____

Please make a note that The Teacher will NOT permit music during the following:

- **Teacher directed instruction – when the teacher is talking**
- **During FCAT Testing**
- **During Benchmark Testing**
- **During Standardized Testing – such as PSAT, ASVAB, etc.**
- **At the teacher's discretion**

V. The Student agrees to allow the Teacher to randomly listen to the music at any time requested.

CONSEQUENCES to violation of Contract:

First Offense:	Loss of privilege for three days of class.
Second Offense:	Loss of privilege for ten days of class.
Third Offense:	Loss of privilege for 45 days of class.
