

Mentor Program



In our Mentor Program, we match teachers or other staff members with students having behavioral issues. These students are selected using the referral data or may also be chosen at the request of the classroom teacher. The student reports to his or her mentor at least once per day.

The mentor also checks in periodically with the classroom teacher to discuss any changes and or improvements in behavior. They may also discuss strategies to help the student improve their behavior.

At this time, we are not collecting any daily data on these students. We do, however, look at their referral rate to determine if the child is becoming more successful at implementing strategies to control undesired behaviors.
