What is PBSES?

- FLPBS: RtI/B Project's online database
- Submit Mid-Year & End-Year Reports
- Provides graphic feedback
 - School-Level Outcomes (ODR, ISS, OSS, Attendance)
 - Fidelity of Implementation (PIC and BoQ)



Why PBSES?

- Helps to identify items for action plans
 - What do we need to work on? What are we doing well?
- Helps to evaluate your progress
 - Are we meeting our goals?
 - Helps to set new goals
- Can use to provide feedback to team
- Can use to provide feedback to entire faculty



How do I Access PBSES?

- Each school has a unique password
- The school's coach has the password and also the DC has a list of passwords

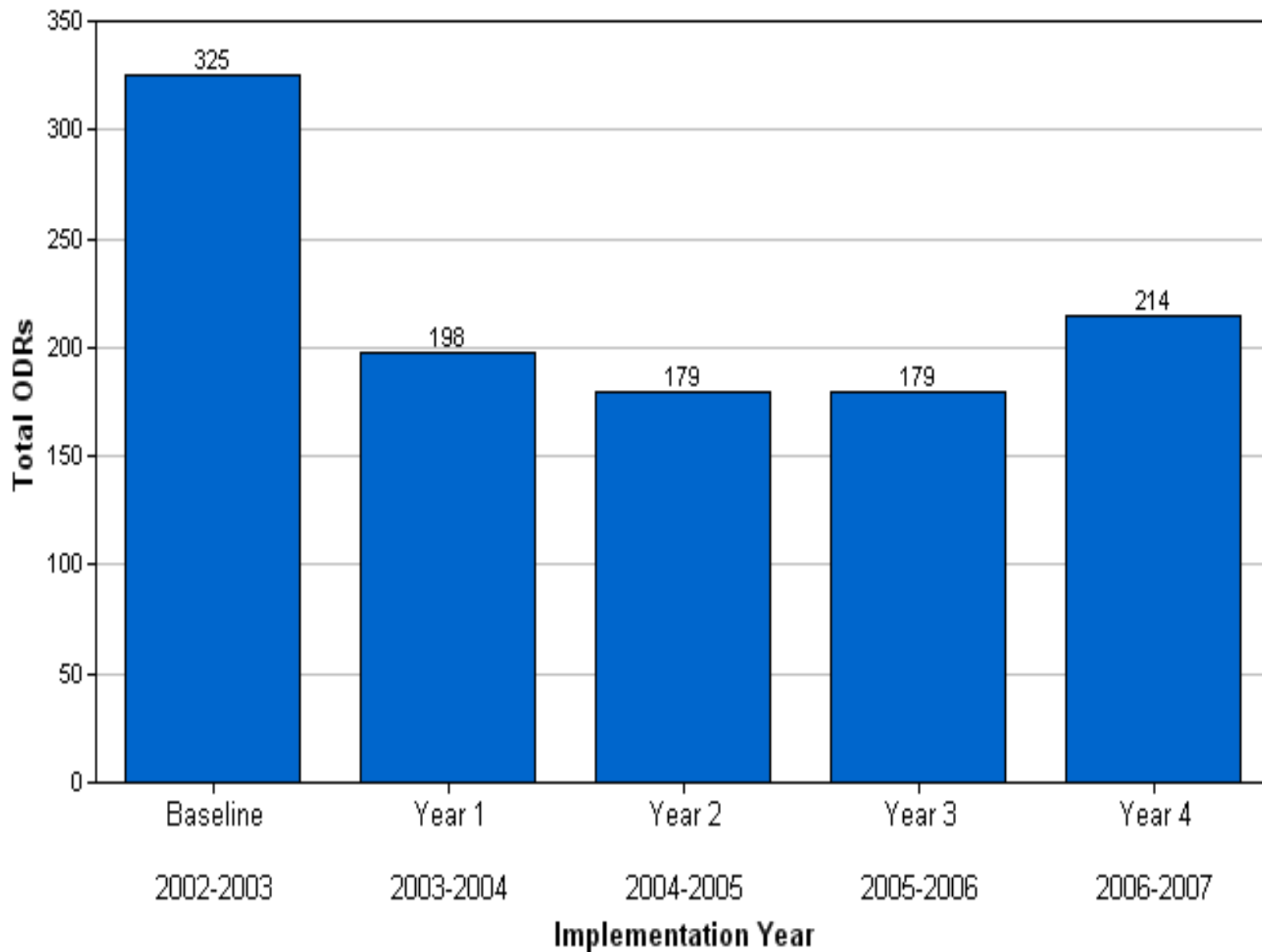

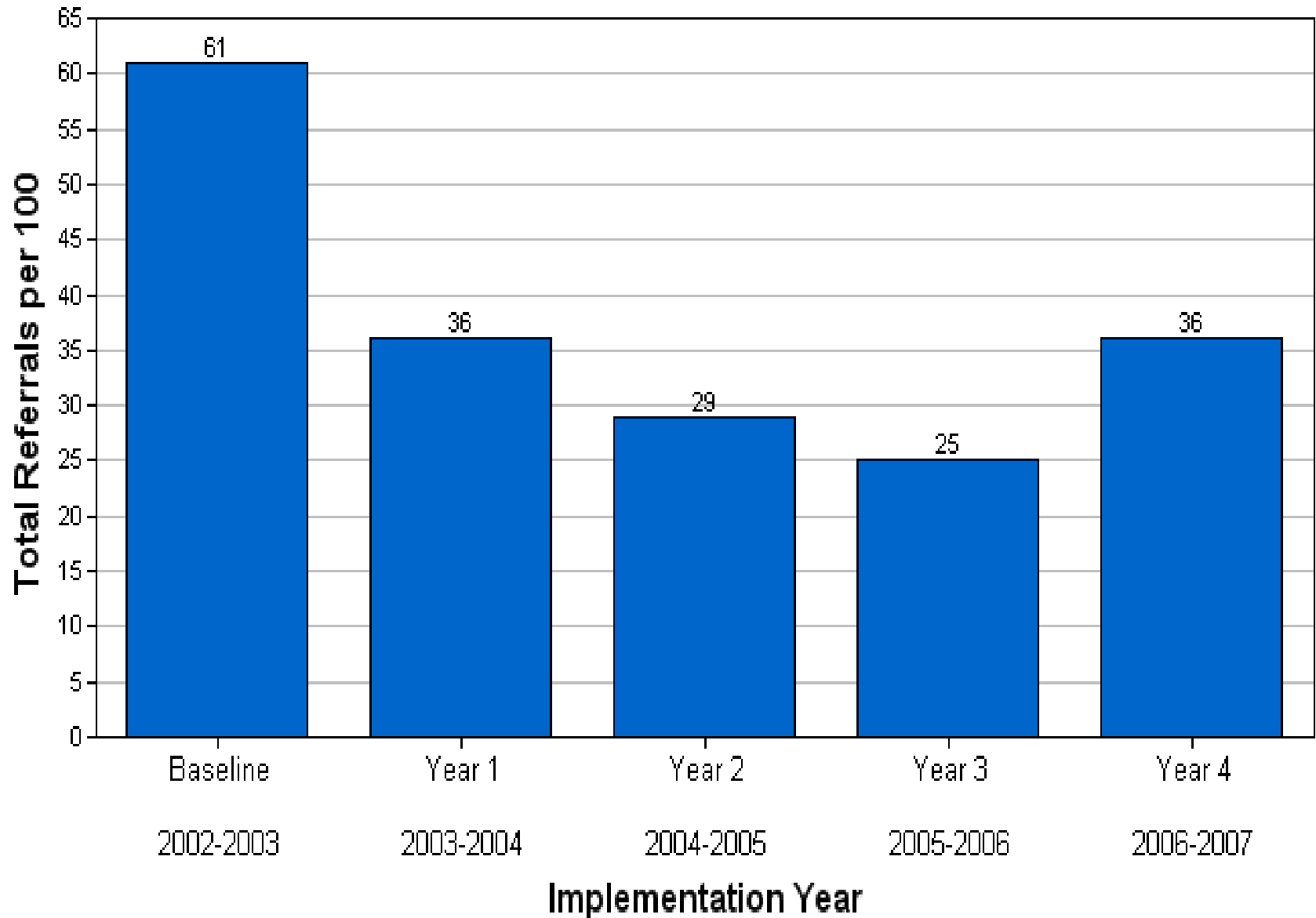

ODRs Over Years of Implementation



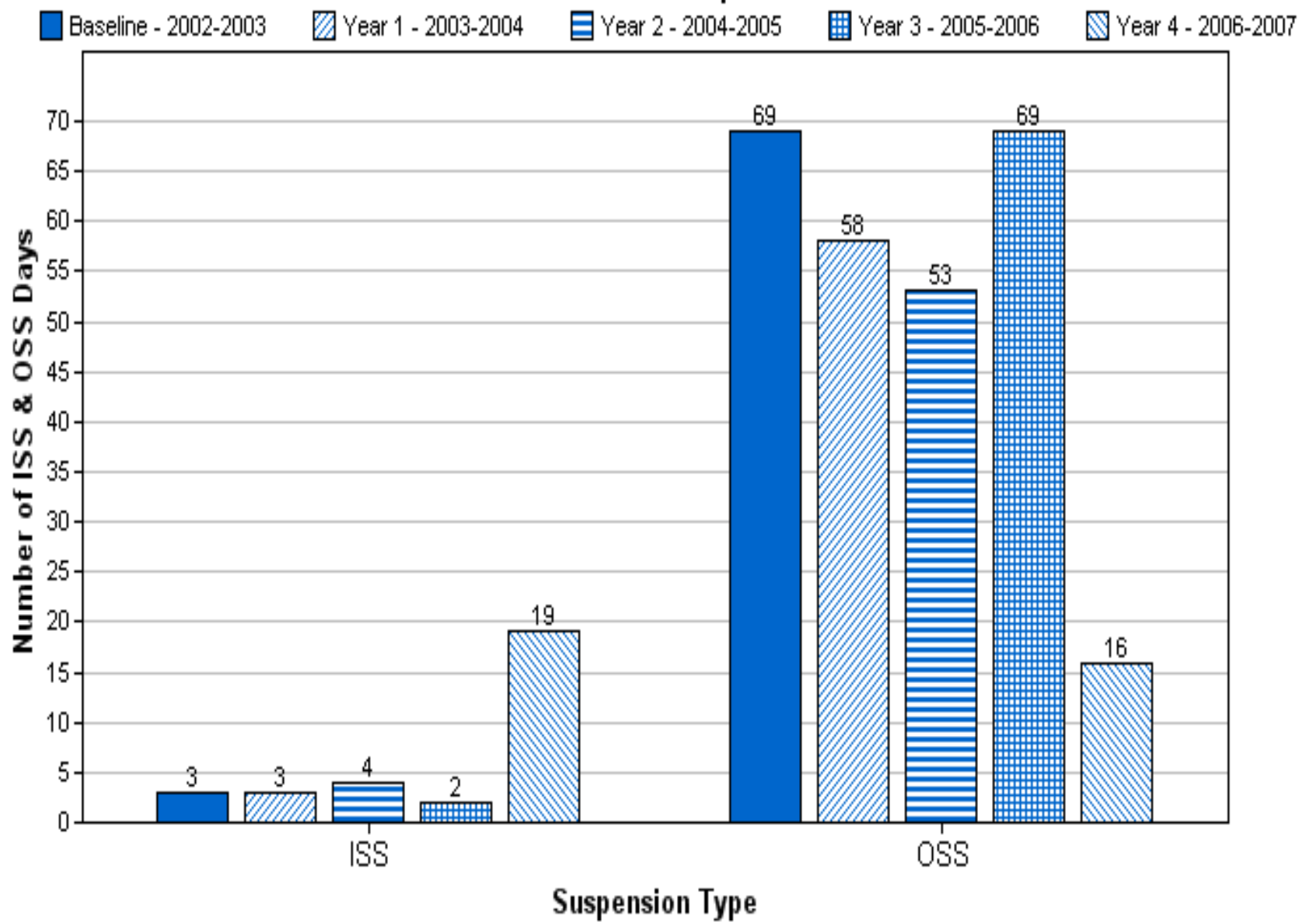
TEST SCHOOL D

Referrals per 100 Students



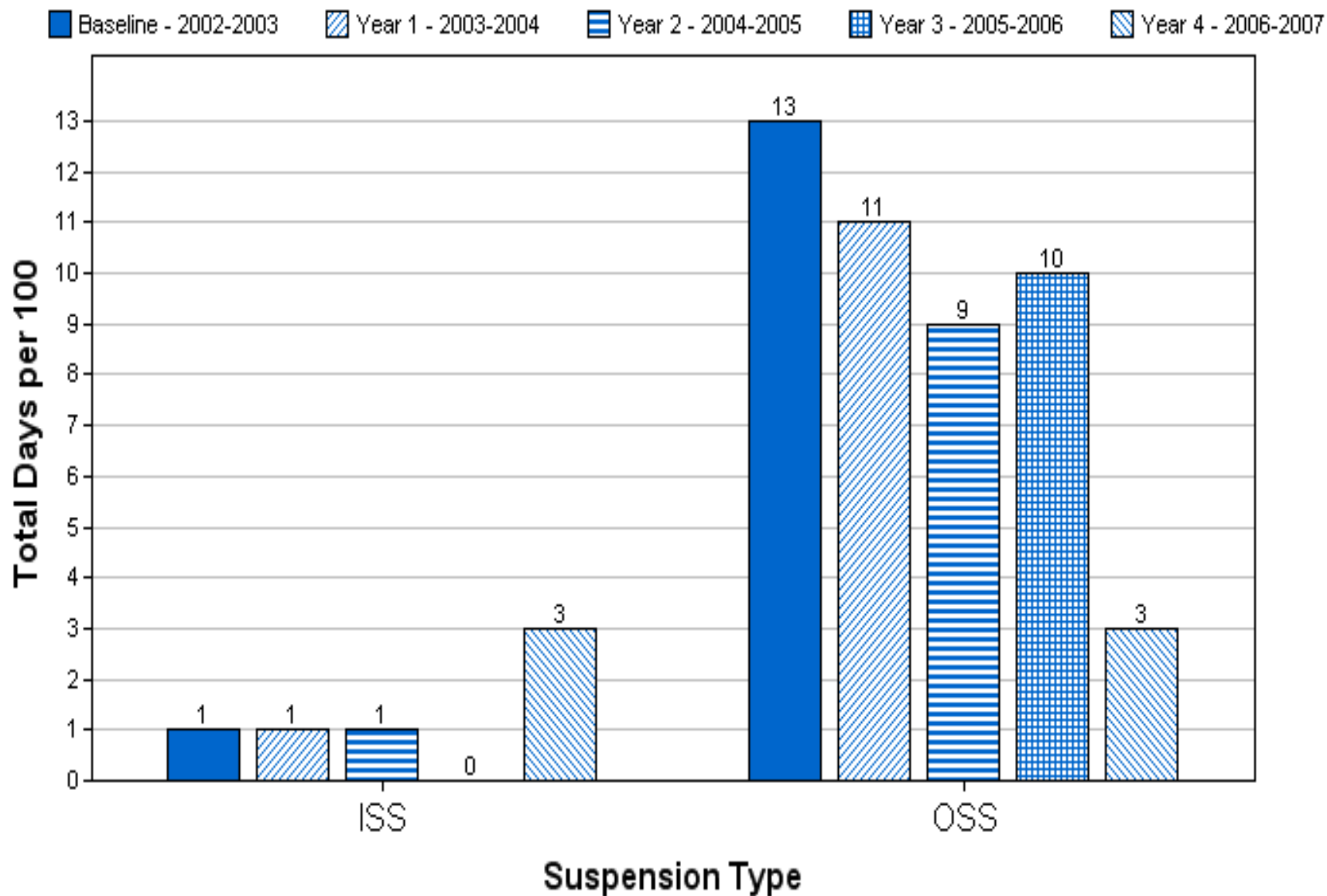

ISS & OSS Over Years of Implementation

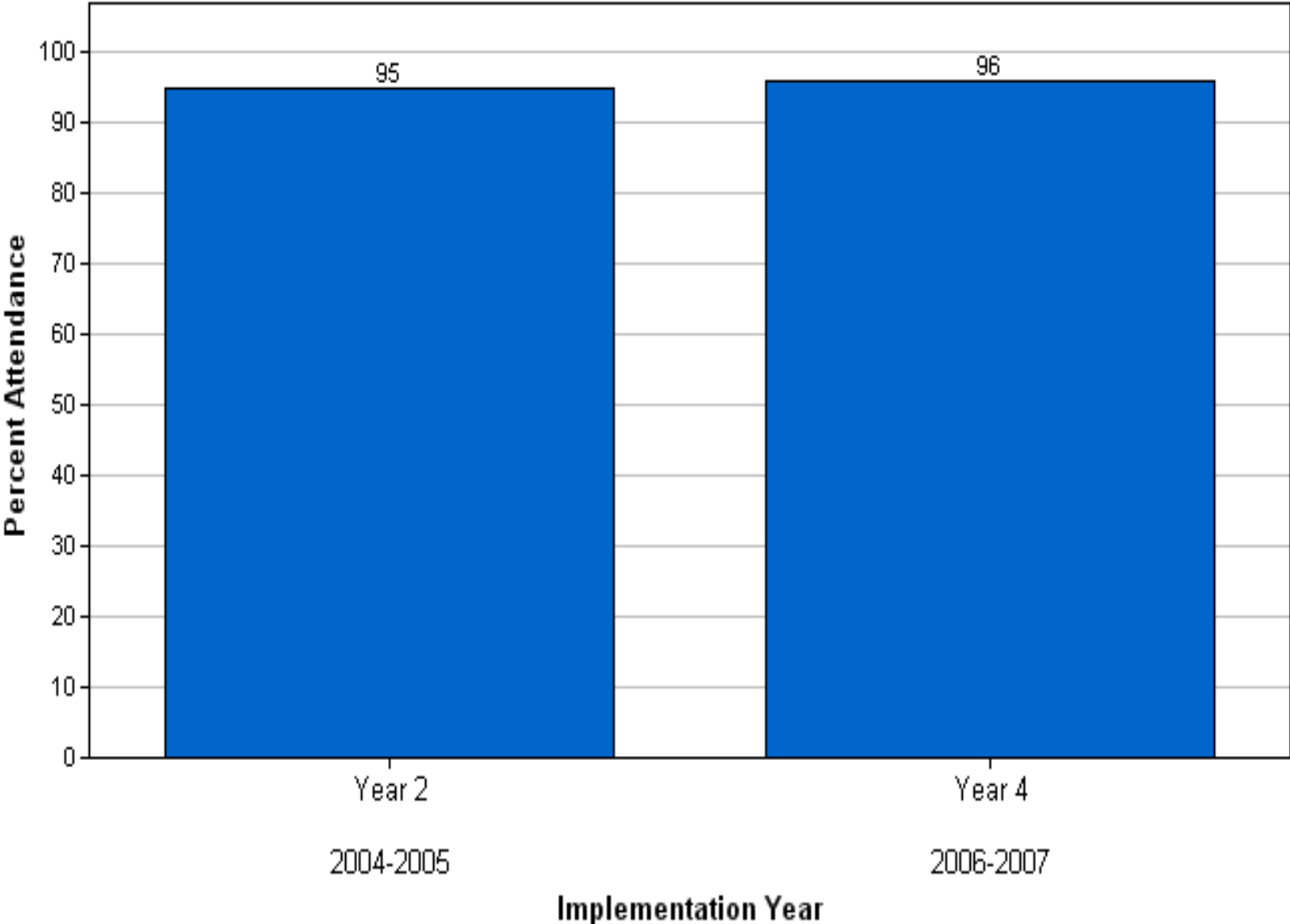

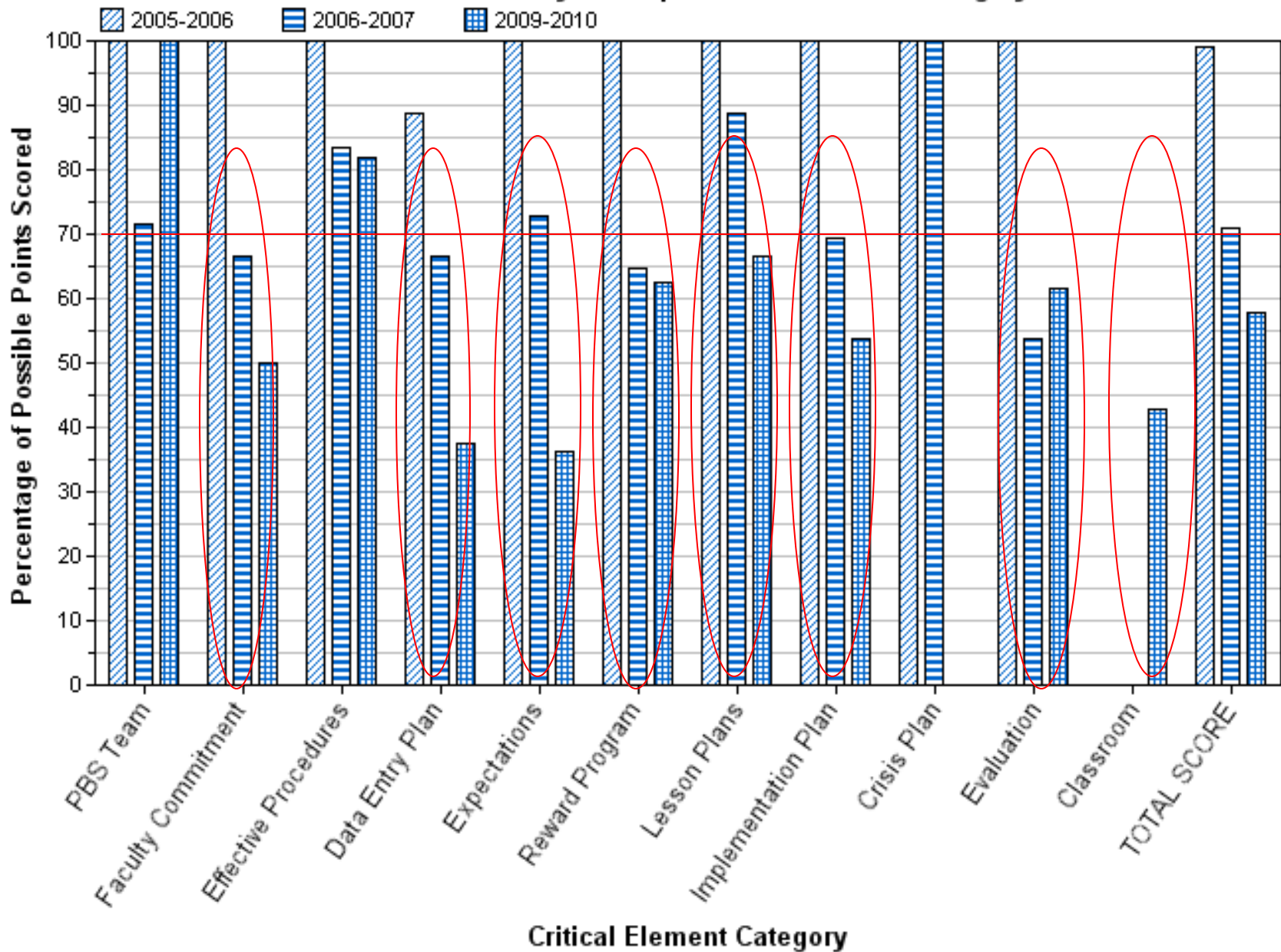


TEST SCHOOL D

Ask questions:

- Where did we do well & need to maintain?
- Where do we focus?
- Why did we score low on some areas?
- Where can we find some resources to “beg, borrow, steal” that have worked for other schools?



Where Do we Focus?

- Any areas lower than 70% on the BoQ
 - Faculty Commitment
 - Data Entry Plans
 - Expectations
 - Reward Program
 - Lesson Plans
 - Implementation Plan
 - Evaluation
 - Classroom

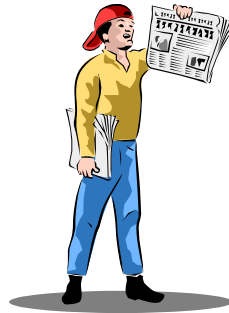
