

Activity 17: Lesson Plan for Rules Worksheet

Teaching Rules (skill level)

1. Setting Dismissal Rules

2. List Expectations

1. Be Respectful
2. Be Responsibilities
3. Be your Best
4. Be Safe

3. Activity for Reviewing Expectations:

Discuss the school-wide expectations while presenting student generated posters, icons or photographs.
Get your passport stamped.

4. Generate Specific Rules for Setting:

Expectation 1: Respectful

Rule A: Use quiet voices at all times.

Example

Having a quiet conversation with a friend

Non-example

Yelling at your friend
Calling names

Expectation 2: Be Responsible

Rule A: Go directly to your designated area.

Example

Going to car circle, bus circle or YMCA when dismissed.

Non-example

Stopping to wait for a friend in another class.

Expectation 3: Be Your Best

Rule A: Keep hands, feet and objects to yourself.

Example

Hands in your own space

Non-example

Swinging your backpack.
Throwing things over the railings.
Hitting, pushing

Expectation 4: Be Safe

Rule A: Sit calmly in your area.

Example

Sit on your bottom with your legs crossed.

Non-example

Moving from spot to spot
Taking things out of your backpack.



5. Activities to Allow Students to Practice Desired Behaviors: Take class out and practice walking to and sitting in the designated area. Model how to sit and choose a spot when you arrive.

**6. Plan for Rewarding Appropriate Behavior:
Earn Compliment Cards in the morning from the teacher monitoring the halls.**
